Besides our hands-on computer classes, the Library now offers one-on-one training in setting up Google email accounts. Call the Reference Desk at 837-3449 to sign up for a 30-minute personal session to create an account and send/receive emails using Gmail. Sessions will be held Tuesday afternoons in October.

While at the Library, you can borrow a laptop computer to use in the Library. Three laptops are available with wireless access. Microsoft Office Suite, and upload/download capabilities. You must be 18 years old to check out a laptop with your library card, and a driver's license or state ID. The first hour is free and each additional hour is \$2.50. Printing is also offered for \$.10 per page after the first page.
