

**HOMER TOWNSHIP  
MIDLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN**

**ORDINANCE NO. 1101**

An ordinance to create and establish a Township group life insurance plan providing life insurance for designated groups of elected or appointed officers; to authorize the Township Supervisor and the Township Clerk to contract, in the name of the Township, for such insurance; to designate the groups of elected and appointed officers to be afforded such insurance; to ratify and confirm the validity of any insurance plan or contracts in existence on the effective date of this ordinance which do not conflict with the provisions of this ordinance; and to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

The Township of Homer, Midland County, Michigan, ordains pursuant to the authority vested in it by Act 77 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan for 1989, as amended, MCL 41.110b, the following ordinance:

**SECTION 1:**

This ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Homer Township 2009 Group Life Insurance Ordinance."

**SECTION 2:**

Pursuant to Act 77 of the Public Acts of 1989, as amended, the Township of Homer hereby creates and establishes a group insurance plan providing life insurance for the elected and appointed Township officers enumerated herein, and also authorizes the Township Supervisor and the Township Clerk to contract, in the name of the Township, subject to approval of the Township Board, with any company authorized to transact such business within the State of Michigan for such insurance policies.

**SECTION 3:**

The group insurance plan created, established and contracted for under this ordinance shall cover each person within the following classes of elected and appointed officers and employees while that person holds that position:

- (1) All members of the Township Board
- (2) Deputy Supervisor
- (3) Deputy Treasurer
- (4) Deputy Clerk

(5) All Township building, electrical, mechanical and plumbing inspectors

(6) Township fire chief

(7) Township maintenance employees

(8) All members of the Township Planning Commission whose uninterrupted service on the Planning Commission commenced prior to January 1, 2009. Not included are members of the Planning Commission appointed and whose first service on the Planning Commission began January 1, 2009 or thereafter.

(9) All members of the Township Board of Review whose uninterrupted service on the Board of Review commenced prior to January 1, 2009. Not included are members of the Board of Review appointed and whose first service on the Board of Review began January 1, 2009 or thereafter.

(10) Township Constables whose uninterrupted service as constable commenced prior to January 1, 2009. Not included are constables elected and whose first service as constable began January 1, 2009 or thereafter.

#### **SECTION 4:**

The Township of Homer shall annually contribute the total cost of the premium or charges arising under such life insurance contracts for each elected or appointed official or employee in Section 3 hereof. Such Township contribution shall be secured from the general fund of the Township.

#### **SECTION 5:**

The Township of Homer hereby ratifies and confirms the validity of any life insurance, plan or any one or more of such forms of insurance in existence on the effective date of this ordinance covering the elected or appointed officials and employees set forth in Section 4.

#### **SECTION 6:**


All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, including Homer Township Ordinance Number 1100, are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect on the date of its publication.
